

Dear Families,

Welcome to Faith Formation 2020-2021! Circumstances certainly have changed in just a year, and our Faith Formation has had to change along with it. Much consideration was made as we discerned how to provide a quality Faith Formation to the students in our parish. We want to keep the students, the catechists, and all family members as safe as possible. The following are the plans for each grade level and Sacrament prep process:

Grades 1-6: We will be using the new Boston Archdiocese plan, called "Project Nazareth", with some supplemental material. This Faith Formation takes place in the home, led by the parents, focusing on a theme based on the upcoming Gospel reading. Along with this lesson will be a "Laying the Foundation" lesson, based on the theme, Here there will be a grade level teaching on the theme, allowing your child to learn at his or her own level, keeping them on task in meeting the curriculum found in our in-house classroom model.

The "textbook" you will be using is the Catholic Children's Bible, which we will provide. You will also receive a Prayer Center Kit, which includes cloths of the Liturgical colors, battery run candle (batteries included!), a small crucifix, and prayer sticks. A Parent guide, Prayer guide, and Guide to the Prayer Center Kit will also be included. The lesson will be mailed to the parents on the Monday preceding the particular Sunday. The lesson will consist of Bible readings that relate to the Sunday theme, whether it is the Gospel itself, or a Liturgical celebration, such as All Saints Day or Advent.

The lesson will ask that you gather as a family, pray together, read the Bible together, and then learn from each other with one or two discussion questions of the week. These questions are meant to be discussed whenever you have a few minutes: during a meal, in the car, on a walk, etc. There will be suggestion for "going deeper", whether in a study format or as a family activity. We just ask that you do what you can, when you can. This time together is not meant to stress anyone out, but to help all members of the family see the connection of our Sunday Liturgies to our daily life, and why we do what we do throughout the year.

Students preparing for the Sacraments of Penance and Eucharist will receive additional materials, and should expect to participate in a Zoom Family Gathering several times throughout the year. The Sacrament of Penance is usually received in December, and the Sacrament of First Eucharist is usually received during the Easter Season (April/May)

Cindy will be holding a Zoom Parent/Family Meeting on Wednesday, September 23 at 7:00 pm, to review the above information, as well as preparation for First Penance/First Eucharist, and answer any questions. Details to join the meeting will be mailed to the parents of all registered students.

Grades 7 and 8: The 7th and 8th graders can expect an online (Zoom) Sunday morning class between 10:15am and 11:15am with age appropriate discernment focused on the following curriculum:

- 1. Identity and development, Becoming who you are called to Be
- 2. Faith: responding to God's Invitation
- 3. Judaism: Discovering our Religious Roots
- 4. Jesus: Revealing God in History
- 5. Jesus and the paschal Mystery
- 6. The Church: Gathering in the Spirit of Jesus
- 7. The Scriptures: Hearing the Inspired Word of God
- 8. Tradition: Handing on a Living Faith
- 9. The Sacraments: Celebrating the Grace of God
- 10. The Liturgical Year Explained
- 11. Spirituality and Prayer: Growing in Life with God
- 12. Christian Morality: Living in the Spirit of Jesus

The plan is to meet 6 times before Christmas and 6 times before Easter. Hopefully we can move to "in-person" gatherings in 2021. Service opportunities are on hold for now with minor exceptions.

High School (Confirmation): All classes will meet at 7pm for one hour through Zoom.

1st year Confirmation candidates choose 3 topics, 2nd year candidates choose 2:

Each topic includes: • opening and closing prayers • contemporary songs/music • videos that frame the issue, make a faith connection to the issue, and inspire a call to action • questions to guide group discussion • youth-friendly activities or reflections. In session one of each topic, the content is animated in two parts: "Making It Personal" and "Changing the World." "Making It Personal" videos, discussion, and exercises focus on personal stories and the faith-based connection to the issue. "Changing the World" focuses on how individuals, Churches and other organizations, have (successfully) responded to the issue, and invites youth to make personal/group commitments to action.

- Generations of Faith (Digital Version) Saturday October 24th. This year the latter part of that event features Trivia, so the presence of High school students would be especially helpful.
- The Confirmation Retreat day is November 7th from 10- 5pm but if we cannot do this in person we will re-schedule for the Spring.
- ABIDEBoston, led by several metrowest parishes and involves teens' prayer, fasting and service between 7pm on Good Friday and 7pm on Holy Saturday. In 2021 it will take place on April 2nd and 3rd at St Bridget's parish in Lexington.

ABOUT OUR FEES:

Full tuition is required for the first two children enrolled.

Supplemental registration for a third child costs only \$50 and subsequent children are free. **Sacramental Preparation Fees** are required for children preparing for First Communion (typically 2nd Grade) and for Confirmation Candidates during their FIRST year Confirmation preparation. This fee covers the cost of meetings, mailings, supplies, programs, etc. for Sacramental Preparation.
